You will need:

- A computer with internet
- A webcam (if using Breeze video)
- A microphone (if using Breeze audio -- USB not recommended)
- Speakers (if using Breeze audio - recommended the headset/mic combo)

Breeze can be used two ways:

1. to store content
2. to host meetings/classes

When using Breeze for classroom discussion (chat), video, audio, link sharing, whiteboard, etc. the instructor first needs to login, create a meeting (classroom area), design/organize layout, prepare all documents or links to be shared and set up all equipment (i.e. webcam, speakers). The instructor then sends the students the specific meeting/class Breeze URL for their access. This URL address can easily be inserted into Blackboard.

The students retrieve the Breeze URL address and enter as a "Guest." It will prompt them for their name and the instructor can accept or decline their access.

- ✓ Meetings can be recorded
- ✓ Students will only be able to use the chat feature **unless the instructor grants them different access (i.e. host, presenter)
