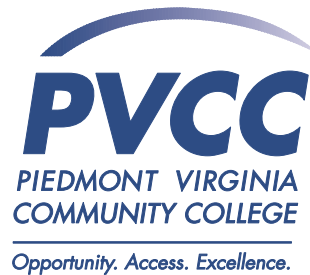
The Career Center offers a variety of job placement services. Regardless of where you are in your career development, we are committed to your job search success!

Job Board - View information about the latest jobs, internships and career events. Located outside the Career Center, room 132.

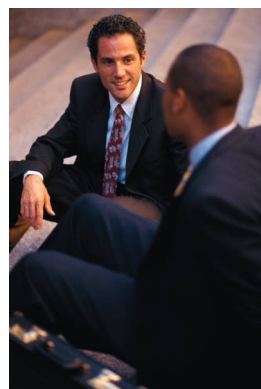
eNewsletter - Get e-mail updates about career-related activities.
