<sup>3</sup> Foreign Language or Elective: Students should complete up to eight semester hours of Applied Music, which can include chorus and ensemble. Foundation courses for music are MUS 111-112 and applied music courses. Students who wish to transfer to the University of Virginia or the College of William and Mary need to take a foreign language through the 202 level.

**Although a course fulfills a requirement for a PVCC program, it is possible the course will not fulfill a requirement at a four-year institution. Students who plan to transfer need to be aware of the four-year institution's requirements.**
