

Nursing Program Admission Checklist

The following requirements must be met by **February 15, 2009** in to be considered for admission:

- ___ Admission/readmission to the college (this is a separate application – admission/readmission to the college must be completed prior to applying for admission to the nursing program)
- ___ Completion of math assessment testing, with placement at the MTH 4 level or higher or completion of developmental Math course(s) through MTH 3 / BSK 9 level or completion of acceptable college-level math course with a grade of “C” or better WITHIN THE PAST 8 YEARS.
- ___ Completion of reading and writing assessment testing, with placement at college level or completion of the developmental English course(s) through ENG 3 and 5.
- ___ Completion of TEAS (or other) Nursing Preadmission testing with a satisfactory score. A composite score of 45% is required for TEAS
- ___ Completion of high school biology and chemistry with a grade of "C" or better or completion of NAS 2 or college level biology and chemistry courses.
- ___ Admission into the General Studies for Nursing curriculum (must be completed by appointment in the counseling office).
- ___ Attendance at mandatory nursing program orientation session – Online or Face-to-Face. YEARLY ATTENDANCE IS REQUIRED.
- ___ Submission of electronic Nursing Program Application
- ___ Submission of official high school transcript* to the Office of Admissions and Records for verification of science prerequisites.
- ___ Submission of official college transcripts, if attended any colleges other than PVCC or another Virginia community college*.

*It is the applicant's responsibility to verify that all transcripts are on file with the Admissions and Records Office.

The Admissions office purges all files that have been inactive for 3 years. You must resubmit all transcripts.

ALL TRANSCRIPTS ARE TO BE SENT TO THE ADMISSIONS OFFICE.
DO NOT HAVE TRANSCRIPTS SENT TO THE NURSING PROGRAM
