

## Retention by Academic Plan

This report displays fall to fall retention by academic plan. A retained student is a student who was enrolled in a specific academic program in the fall and re-enrolls in the college in the same academic program in the following fall term. A student is eligible to return if they have not graduated from that academic program between the two fall terms being analyzed. A student who has graduated between the two examined fall terms is excluded. This report includes students primary, secondary, and trinary plans. 3-year averages are not shown for programs with less than 3 years of retention data.
