

Kid's College Subsequent Enrollment at PVCC

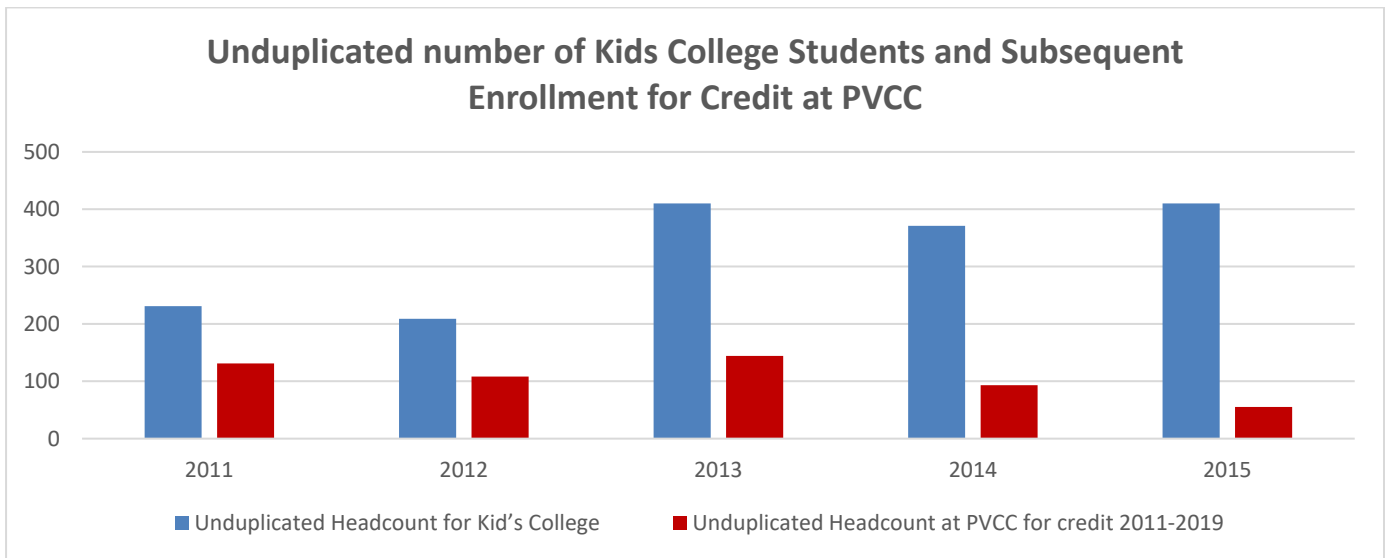
Purpose and Background: The purpose of this research was to determine if Kid's College participants enrolled in credit classes at Piedmont Virginia Community College (PVCC). Kid's College participants are 1st through 9th grade students. Kid's College began in Summer of 2010 with participants enrolling in subsequent summers. The earliest a Kid's College participant could enroll for credit at PVCC would be Fall of 2012 as a dual enrollment student in the high school setting.

Methodology:

This study examined unduplicated enrollment for Kid's College for cohorts 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, and 2015 to determine if there was credit enrollment at PVCC in academic years 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, or 2019.

Results:

When examining the combined cohort years of 2011-2015, there was an unduplicated count of 1489 with 495 of those students enrolling in credit courses at PVCC. This resulted in a yield of 33%.

Discussion:

In 2011, 131 (57%) of Kids College students enrolled for credit at PVCC in 2011-2019. The percent of students enrolling for credit at PVCC decreases in 2012, 2013, 2014, and 2015; however, these students have had less time to enroll in credit classes at PVCC. These numbers will be updated in the following years to capture Kids College student's subsequent enrollment at PVCC. In total, 495 (33%) of the students who participated in Kids College for the years 2011-2015 have enrolled at PVCC for credit courses from 2011-2019.
