Average student load refers to the hours of course work taken by students. Full-time students are those taking 12 or more credit hours of course work. First-time students have never attended college before; transfer students have attended college elsewhere and are new to PVCC; returning students have attended PVCC previously. Career/technical (Occupational/Technical in previous semesters) students are those enrolled in programs leading toward Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degrees or certificates; college transfer students are those enrolled in programs leading toward Associate of Arts (AA) or Associate of Science (AS) degrees; unclassified students are not enrolled in any curricular programs. Off-campus students are those who take all classes at a location other than the main PVCC campus. Evening students are those who take only evening classes.
