

2019-2020 Regional Public High School Graduates at PVCC

Fall 2020 Enrollment

Recent regional public high school graduates represent 10% of Piedmont Virginia Community College’s (PVCC) total headcount of credit-seeking students in the fall of 2020. PVCC enrolled 486 (20%) of the 2019-2020 graduates at the ten public high schools in the PVCC service region in the fall of 2020. The table below shows the number of graduates from each high school, the number of those graduates who enrolled at PVCC, and percent of graduates who enrolled at PVCC in fall 2020, 2019, and 2018.

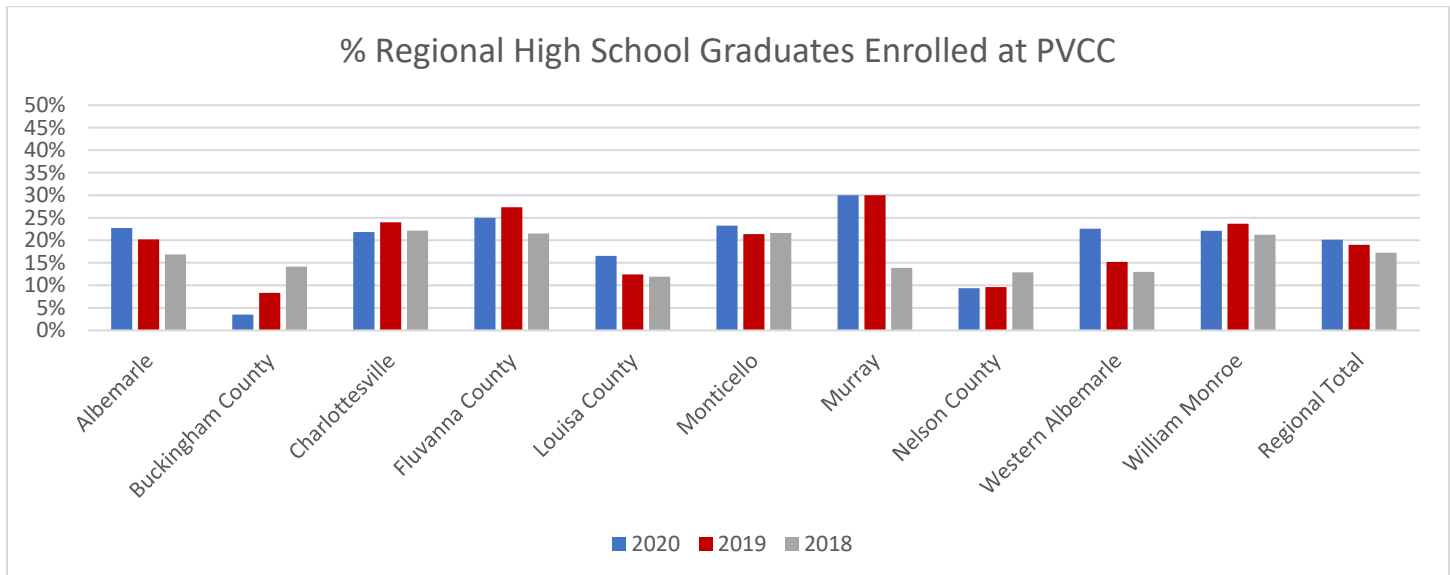

The following graph displays the overall trends in high school graduates in the PVCC service region who enrolled in courses at PVCC. Overall, the percent of regional high school graduates who enrolled in courses at PVCC has increased 1% from 2019 to 2020 and increased 3% from 2018 to 2020.



PVCC offers dual enrollment courses at nine regional high schools. The table below displays the number of 2020 high school graduates who were previously dual enrolled at some point in the academic year 2019-2020. In fall 2020, 56% of regional high school graduates who enrolled in courses were previously dual enrolled in 2019-20.

The following graph displays the overall trends in high school graduates who enrolled in courses at PVCC who were previously enrolled in dual enrollment courses. Overall, the percent of regional high school graduates who enrolled in courses at PVCC who were also previously dual enrollment students decreased 6% from 2019 to 2020 and increased 5% from 2018 to 2020.
