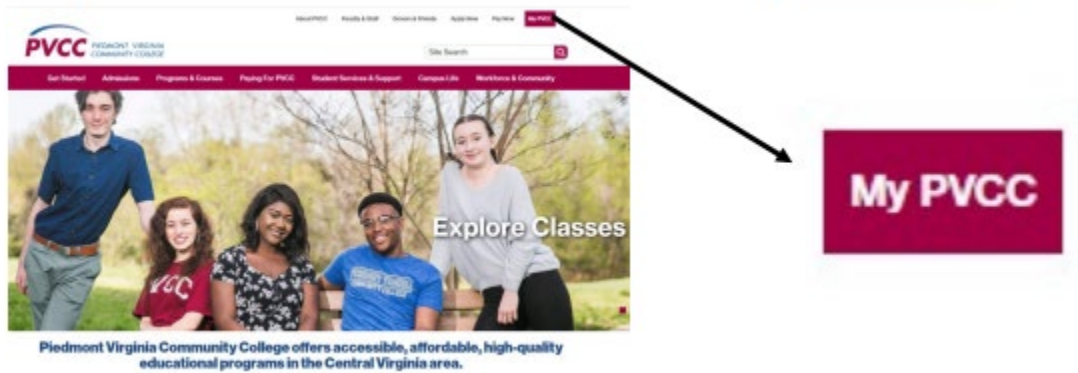


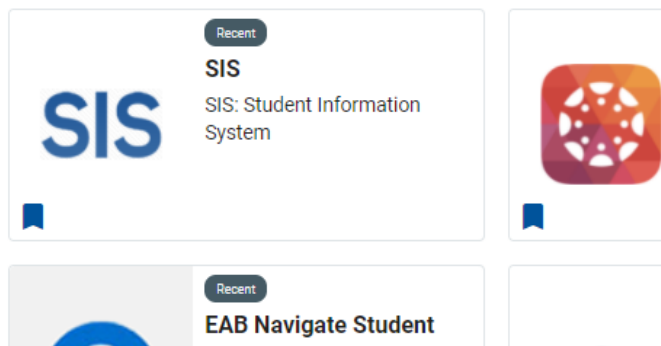
How to View Your Advisement Report

- 1) Log into your MyPVCC account from the PVCC home page, www.pvcc.edu, in the upper right-hand corner:

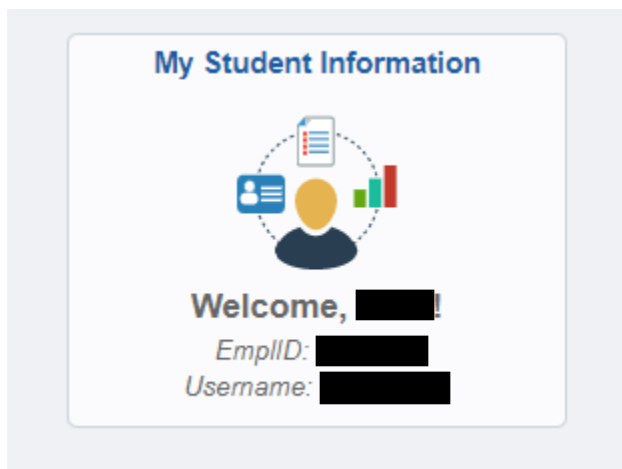


- 2) Click into your SIS, SIS: Student Information System, module:

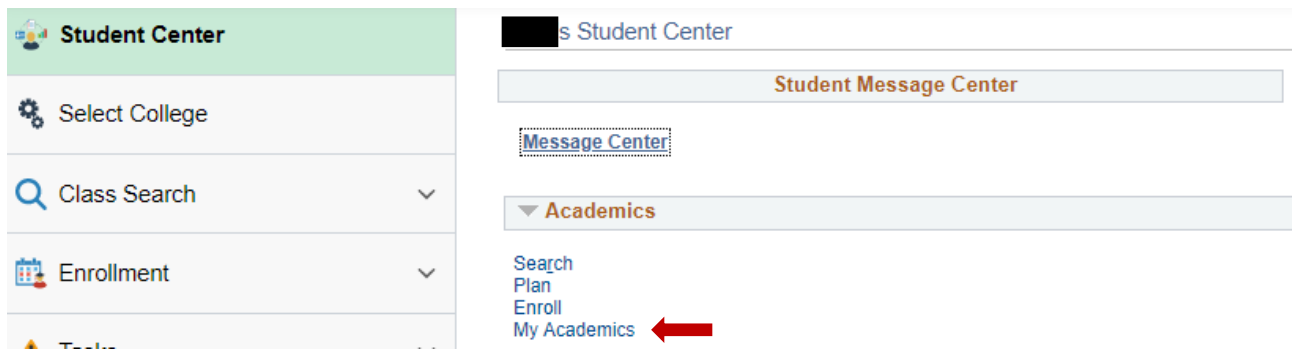

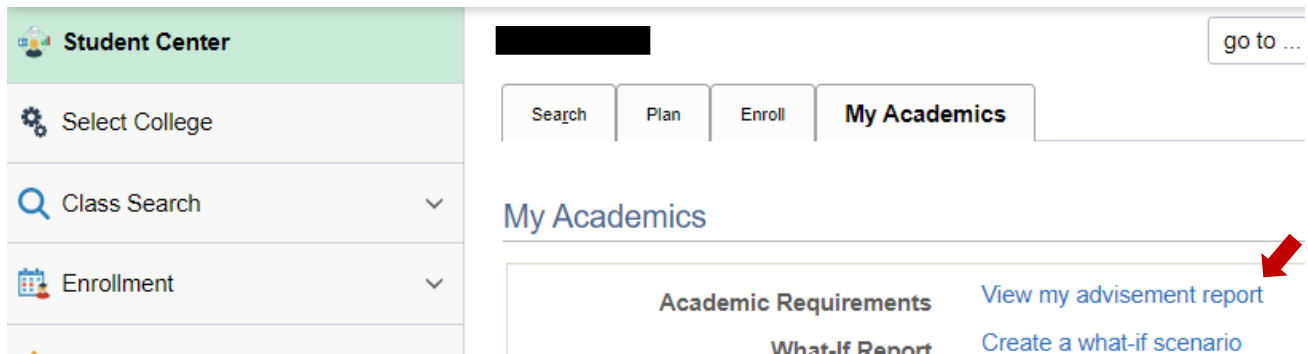
- 3) On the home dashboard, click into your My Student Information tile:



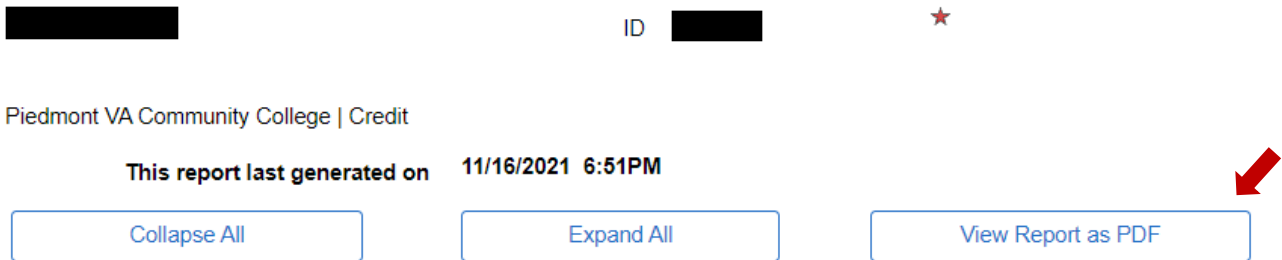
4) From your student center, click on the My Academics link:

You must enroll in the *section* that contains the designation for the Writing Intensive and/or Civic Engagement component to be awarded this requirement.
