



Graduate Profile 2021-2022

This profile is prepared annually in advance of PVCC's spring commencement. The data presented below represent the total *degree and certificate completers* from the Summer 2021 and Fall 2021, and Spring 2022 *graduation applicants and estimates recipients of the General Studies Certificate and the Health Sciences Preparation Career Studies Certificate*. The actual number of degrees and certificates earned by PVCC students in 2021-22 will be finalized and reported after the Registrar certifies all spring graduates. There will likely be a difference between estimated and actual numbers due to some spring graduation applicants not fulfilling all their degree requirements this semester.

Number of Graduates and Degrees

It is **estimated** that **790** students will graduate from PVCC with at least one degree, certificate, or career studies certificate for the 2021-2022 academic year. Some students earn more than one, resulting in an **estimated 1,074** degrees, certificates, and career studies *certificates* awarded for the academic year.

Demographics of 2021-22 Projected Graduates

- 61% female, 38% male, 1% not reported
- 7% Asian, 10% black/African American, 6% Hispanic, 5% two or more races, 69% white, and 3% other ethnic groups
- 5% are age 17 and younger, 43% are 18-21, 15% are 22-24, 22% are 25-34, and 15% are age 35 and over
- 30% from Albemarle, 1% from Buckingham, 14% from Charlottesville, 9% from Fluvanna, 16% from Greene, 8% from Louisa, 4% from Nelson, and 18% from outside PVCC's service region.
