

2016-2017 Regional Public High School Graduates at PVCC

Fall 2017 Enrollment

Recent regional public high school graduates represent 8.4% of Piedmont Virginia Community College's (PVCC) total headcount of credit-seeking students in the fall of 2017. PVCC enrolled 458 (18%) of the 2016-2017 graduates at the ten public high schools in the PVCC service region. The table below shows the number of graduates from each high school, the number of those graduates who enrolled at PVCC, and percent of graduates who enrolled at PVCC in fall 2017, 2016, and 2015.

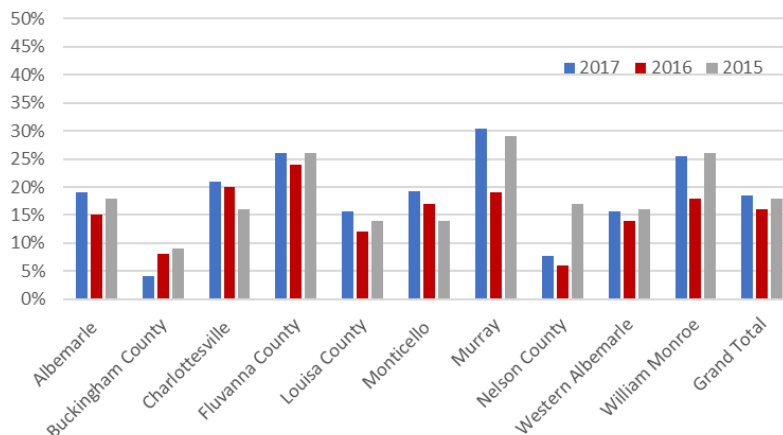

The following graph displays the overall trends in high school graduates in the PVCC service region who enrolled in courses at PVCC. Overall, the percent of regional high school graduates who enroll in courses at PVCC has increased 3% from 2016 to 2017 and decreased 2% from 2015 to 2016.

PVCC offers dual enrollment courses at eight regional high schools. The table below displays the number of 2017 high school graduates who were previously dual enrolled at some point since spring 2016. In fall 2017, 52% of regional high school graduates who enrolled in courses were previously dual enrolled.

The following graph displays the overall trends in high school graduates who enroll in courses at PVCC who were previously enrolled in dual enrollment courses. Overall, the percent of regional high school graduates who enroll in courses at PVCC who were also previously dual enrollment students has increased 2% from 2015 to 2016 and 8% from 2016 to 2017.
