Program Specific WICs:

Biotechnology (AS) students will take BIO 256-01WI: General Genetics (Fall only), which has the additional pre-requisite of BIO 101 + 102.
Science (AS) students may take CHM 241-01 + CHM 243-01WI: Organic Chemistry I + Lab (Fall only), which has the additional pre-requisite of CHM 111 + 112. Science AS students may also select from any other "WI" class, including BIO 256-01WI (fall), and the Humanities or Social Science Electives listed above.
Engineering (AS) students have the option to take EGR 295-01WI , which is offered in the Fall and Spring semesters, and changes topics each semester (Fall: Intro. to Systems Engineering & Spring: Data and Info. Engineering). Both have the additional pre-requisites of CSC 110 and MTH 264 <u>and</u> a co-requisite of MTH 265. Engineering AS students also have the option to take any of the Humanities or Social Science Electives listed above.

Associate of Applied Science (AAS) Program Specific WICs:
